Competition Venue

The Sorraia River is born in the parish of Couço and results in the junction of the Sor and the Raia Streams. Is the Portuguese Tejo's affluent with the biggest hydrographic basin, with approximately 7730km², receiving various streams along its course, the main ones being the Erra, Divor and Juliano rivers.

This river has a vital role for the region, since the time the Romans and the Moors settled here, using the river for agriculture and communications purposes, to export products cultivated in the fertile lands of the Sorraia Valley, where they developed intricate irrigation systems that have been in use until our days.

Abound in the Sorraia River various species, namely barbells, boops, carps, bleaks, mullets and carassius, having developed the artisanal fishing. This species richness has turned the Sorraia river into a privileged place for the practice of sportive fishing, being considered one of the best spots for national and international competitions.



Characteristics of the Sorraia River

- Width: ± 60 to 80 meters
- Depth: 1,5 to 3,5 meters
- The water is not very clear and has a slow stream
- Sandy ground and margins, with some vegetation

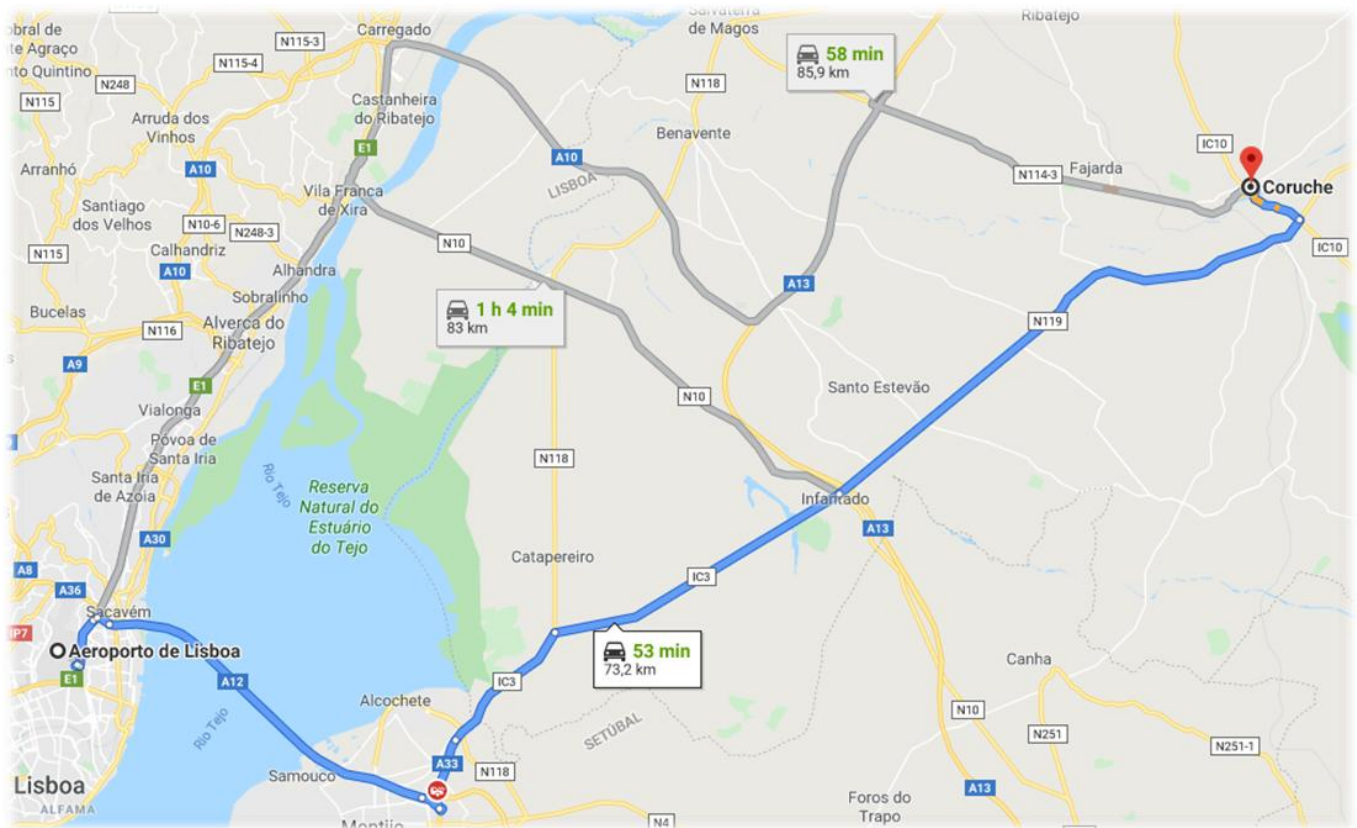

How to get to Coruche

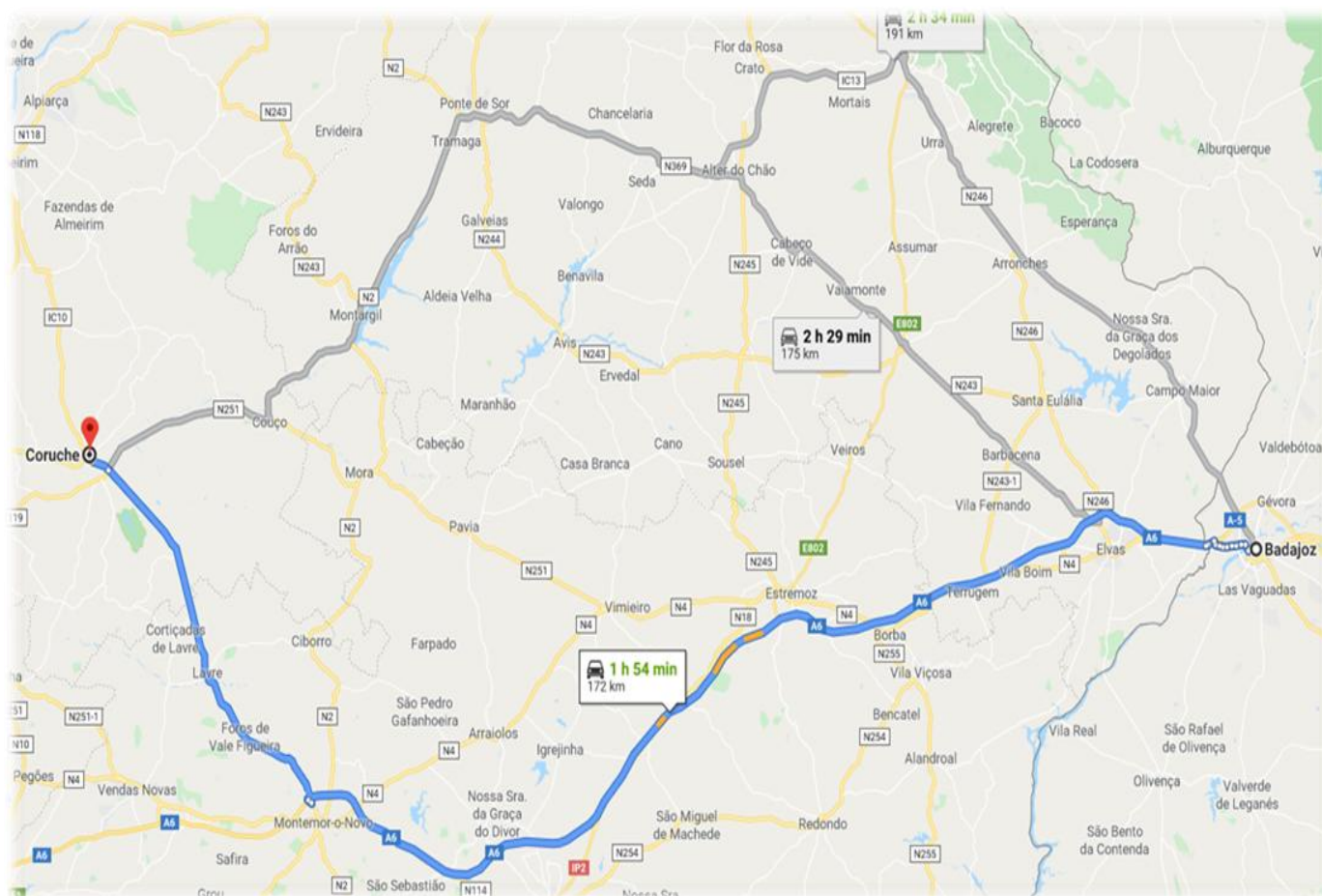
Arrival by plane - International Airport of Lisbon

- Follow the A12 in direction to the Vasco da Gama Bridge (Ponte Vasco da Gama);
- Exit to IC3 in direction to Porto Alto/Alcochete, until the intersection to Coruche;
- Follow the N119 to Coruche.

- **Disabled: 1.300,00€** (this value includes: 8 banquets, 5 licenses, insurance and organization expenses).

Participating nations cover accommodation costs on their own. The organizer does not provide accommodation.

For accompanying persons, the gala dinner ticket cost is **€ 60,00** per person.

The Federations, in addition to the medals devoted to the official members of the Delegation, will be allowed to ask for extra medals (up to a maximum of 3 per team), upon payment of a contribution of € 25 per extra medal, which will also include the diploma. The fees for extra medals shall be paid to F.I.P.S.e.d. In no case and for no reason extra medals in a number higher than that provided by these Rules may be requested from F.I.P.S.e.d.

FIPSeD Rules:



Age Limit - Masters: Must be 55 years old by December 31st of 2024 (born in the year 1969 or before).

The names of the 5 competitors must be finalised and communicated to the organisers at the time of the accreditation of their delegation; these names may not be changed subsequently, except in cases of force majeure

Only the 5 official members of the team (4 anglers and 1 reserve) will be allowed to fish on the venue during training days.

ANTI-DOPING INFORMATION TUE REQUESTS

The athletes participating in the Championship, with the registration, implicitly accept all WADA anti-doping rules. Athlete whose illness or condition requires treatment with a prohibited substance or method must apply to CIPS for a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) following the CIPS strict TUE application process.

He/she shall then use the application form, which can be downloaded from the ITA website:

Athletes must therefore consult the Prohibited List: https://www.wada-ama.org/sites/default/files/2023-09/2024list_en_final_22_september_2023.pdf

If the TUE is granted, the athlete will then be permitted to use the medication during the period of validity of the TUE without committing an Anti-Doping Rules Violation (ADRV).

Regardless of whether a TUE has been granted or not, athletes should always declare on the doping control forms filled out during sample collection any medications and supplements taken within the seven days prior to sample collection, and any blood transfusions in the three months prior for blood samples.

If a TUE has already been granted by a NADO or by a RADO, the Athlete in question does not have to apply for any additional CIPS TUE, as CIPS recognizes all TUE granted by NADOs and RADOs.
